**4** Please pray for the 2020 Budgeting process. The new financial reporting structure requires some changes to the budget process.

**5** Pray that God will continue to strengthen the TTB team in Kumasi as they continue to labour for a great harvest of souls in that region of Ghana. Through their ministry, people are won or re-committed to the Lord every month.

**6** Pray that God prepares the hearts of the people of Northern Nigeria and its surrounds as the Oasis Transmitter Project prepares its broadcasts.

**7** Pray for continued vision and inspiration to TWR's national partners in Africa and worldwide.

**8** Pray that God will continue to use TWR to proclaim His unchanging message in this changing world.

**9** Please pray for spiritual and physical healing for listeners in Africa devastated by war or natural disasters.

**12** Pray that God will use TWR Africa's programmes to encourage listeners to positively affect the lives of friends and family.

**13** Pray for the West African Transmitting Station (*WATS*), that God will continue to bless the team and for the smooth running of this station. Pray for grace to continue to extend their reach throughout West and Central Africa.

**14** Today is Stuart Gordon, TWR Africa Human Resources Director's birthday. Ask God to guide him as he serves alongside his wife Andrea. Pray for good health, a closer walk with the Lord and joy in his service.

**15** Pray for strength and good health for the Africa Media Services team as they diligently work in the areas of compiling radio programmes, tracking production and billing of programmes, IPR, coordination of media and project reporting, schedule changes, and the development and coordination of media partners.

**16** Pray for TWR Malawi, that its radio ministry continues to give hope to Malawians as the country is periodically hit by food shortages. This tropical southern African country relies heavily on rain-fed agriculture and most of its maize is grown on small plots by subsistence farmers.

**18** Pray for Ivory Coast; there has been an alarming rise in the number of kidnap cases reported in Abidjan and other neighbouring cities. Children are kidnapped daily and murdered for ritual purposes. Pray that God will protect His people, and that those behind these heinous acts will be arrested.

**19** We thank God for various TWR projects and programmes that have been successfully accomplished in the first half of this year. Ask for God's guidance and provision as we approach the second half of the year.

**20** Pray for churches to enthusiastically support Christians who are the light to those in darkness especially those who are persecuted, tortured, imprisoned, or in danger of being killed in various African countries.

**21** Pray for TWR volunteers who assist in the TWR ministries in different roles like translations and other ministerial jobs. May the good Lord bless them and their families as they continue to give their time at TWR.

**22** West and Central Africa needs the Gospel now more than ever. Please pray that God will inspire and direct TWR on the best way to channel its strength in such a way that it will bring in a great harvest of souls.

**23** Pray for listeners to the broadcasts of TWR programmes in Mozambique, Zimbabwe and Malawi to follow Christ daily and keep trusting God despite the challenges they face caused by the recent cyclone Idai.

**24** Please continue to pray for the WeCAf (*West and Central Africa*) Team, that God will continue to use them to speak hope to the region through broadcasts in many indigenous languages.
